OVERVIEW

Reporting to the Fleet Coordinator, the Mobile Fleet Mechanic contributes to Arctic Arrow Powerline Group Ltd. success by performing scheduled preventative maintenance, government inspections and necessary repairs to automobiles, trucks (light and heavy), trailers and material handling equipment. This individual also disassembles and overhauls motors, transmissions, clutches, rear ends, hydraulics and electrical systems. This skilled position is located in the Fort St John, BC facility with expanded coverage of the Dawson Creek, BC facility and extended coverage of the Surrey, BC facility. This is a full time role.

RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Maintain and repair all AAPG fleet equipment & assets
2. Flawless execution of the AAPG preventative maintenance & inspection programs
3. Diagnose vehicle failures and disassemble, repair and reassemble parts as necessary
4. Respond to road calls
5. Complete all necessary documents, including vehicle records
6. Maintain cleanliness in areas of work
7. Maintain records of daily check list (pre-trip inspections)
8. Perform all assigned duties in a safe and productive manner
9. Follow the direction from the Region Fleet Coordinator

QUALIFICATIONS

1. High School Diploma or equivalent GED required
2. Valid Interprovincial certification as a heavy duty or commercial transport mechanic
3. Province of British Columbia and Alberta commercial vehicle inspectors certificate (Air Brake Certified)
4. Strong computer skills, mathematical skills and ability to read/write in English
5. Experience with tractors, trucks, trailers, vans, pickups, cars, hydraulics, excavators, etc.
6. Must have valid driver's license in good standing, AZ/Class 1 requested
7. Minimum of 2 years work experience required with preventative maintenance on trucks and industrial equipment; diesel, gas, propane and electrical powered
8. Knowledge of hydraulic and air brake systems required
9. Welding and electrical experience preferred
10. Must be able to provide own tool set for the work required
11. Familiar with safe operation of hand tools
12. Must be able to work independently with minimal supervision

13. Must be able to perform frequent standing, bending, twisting, kneeling, squatting, reaching and grasping
14. Must be able to work shifts and overtime as required
15. Team player who shows initiative, reliability & flexibility
16. Other duties as assigned

This position will supply mechanic support to Fort St John, Dawson Creek, BC and assigned project locations. It is anticipated this position may require up to 50% travel between AAPG locations.
